1. Opening Remarks – Joe Pacheco

3. On Field Evaluations

Five Kingston officials attended the Level I/II Clinicians course on August 15th. In order to address the backlog of Level II evaluations, a sheet was handed out where officials desiring an evaluation could indicate.

4. 2010 Collision At The Causeway

The process started with an attempt to secure 16 senior teams. This appeared to be accomplished until KASSAA confirmed that the season would not commence until the

week of September 20th. This being the case some schools felt they would not have enough practice time to participate.

Graeme provided an updated schedule for officials working the event. The reduction in teams led to a shorter working day for officials. Most of the crews will be made of three.

Since the event should make a comfortable profit, it was decided that each official would be compensated \$10 per game. This small fee is an acknowledgement to officials for their dedication to the Association.

Queen's University has provided 200 student side tickets for the game on Sunday. This game is the season opener following the Vanier Cup Championship.

Joe Pacheco negotiated a fee for first-aid personnel that is less than was paid last year.

A punt, pass, and field goal competition will take place at 1:50 p.m. on the Friday – prizes will be awarded to the winners.
